## Administrative Council Meeting Minutes - August 28, 2025

Those in attendance: Becky Breeding, Alicia Copeland, Cindy Deavers, Martha Fretwell, Wanda Harding, Linda Howdyshell, Beth Howdyshell, Bill Lalla, Laura Jenner, Corey Johnson, Susan Mehler, Bruce Rogers, Cindy Sheets, Karen Whitmer and Sandy Wyrick.

Becky Breeding called the meeting to order. Cindy Deavers read a devotion on: 'Promises about Happiness"

The minutes from the July 2025 meeting were reviewed. A correction was made to the Treasurer's Report that the apportionments in the amount of \$1,910 are paid out monthly, not quarterly, as stated in the July minutes. The corrections were accepted and the minutes to the July meeting were approved with the corrections.

#### Staff Parish Relations Committee: (Sandy Wyrick reported)

- The parsonage has been cleaned. The heat in the parsonage has been repaired.
- We do not have anyone starting as our new pastor on September 1st.
- We are looking for a part-time pastor with a salary range of \$20,000-\$25,000 per year. We would have to set up the guidelines for a new part-time pastor. He/She would work for us on average 20 hours per week, and they would be here every Sunday to preach. With a part-time pastor we would not have to pay out health insurance, which would save us an additional \$19,120 per year minimum. There would be no housing allowance given, the part-time pastor can either live in the parsonage or find his/her own housing. We are hoping to have a new pastor by September 15th.
- Pastor Jim has agreed to stay on for two more weeks, for half of his salary. But, he will only be available for preaching on Sundays and for emergencies only.

#### **Treasurer:** (Cindy Deavers reported)

- We have paid Weekday Religious Education (WRE), Valley Mission (\$500), the Verona Food Pantry (\$500) and Camp Overlook (\$472), the amounts that were agreed upon in last month's church council meeting. All of these monies were paid out of the Gift and Memorial Fund.
- All bills and payroll have been paid for August.

## **Budget**: (Bruce Rogers)

- We worked on our 2026 budget. Most budget line items remained the same. Please see Bruce Rogers or Cindy Deavers for more details on the 2026 proposed budget.

#### **Events:**

- Our next District Conference will be on Sunday, November 9th at 3:00pm at Dayton UMC.
- Becky needs all reports in by October 5th.
- Coffee SHOP will be this Sunday, August 31, 2025 from 9:45am-10:15am. Breakfast items will be available and Susan Mehler will have devotions and prayer.
- We will host a Wednesday Night Community Dinner on Wednesday, October 8th from
   5:30pm-6:30pm inside the Social Hall. We will have hot dogs, hamburgers, and two sides. A free-will offering will be taken. Wanda made a motion and Linda seconded it.
- We will work on reviving 50"s Night in 2026.

### **New Business:**

- Equipping the Saints, a charity in Weyers Cave, is willing to take donated items, including old
   Upper Rooms, and other religious literature that we have in the church.
- The first Sunday in September, we will make a change to the bulletin. The Offertory and
  Attendance section in the bulletin will change to only being published once a month and
  will reflect the Average giving and the Average attendance for the previous month.
   This will allow us to give a more accurate reflection of what our month giving and attendance is.

Becky closed the meeting with prayer. The meeting ended at 8:06pm.
